- Children will participate in an evidence based programme called '*Friends of Life*'. The aim of this programme is to help children build social-emotional skills such as resilience and confidence. It will also help children develop empathy, help regulate emotions and improve their capacity to relax. Furthermore, it will teach children strategies to deal with anxiety and life challenges.
- Children will participate in a spelling programme called '*Words their Way*'. The Words Their Way Programme adopts a word study approach to spelling which moves away from the traditional system of spelling teaching, instead emphasising the value of teaching pupils processes and strategies for examining and thinking about the words they spell, read and write.
